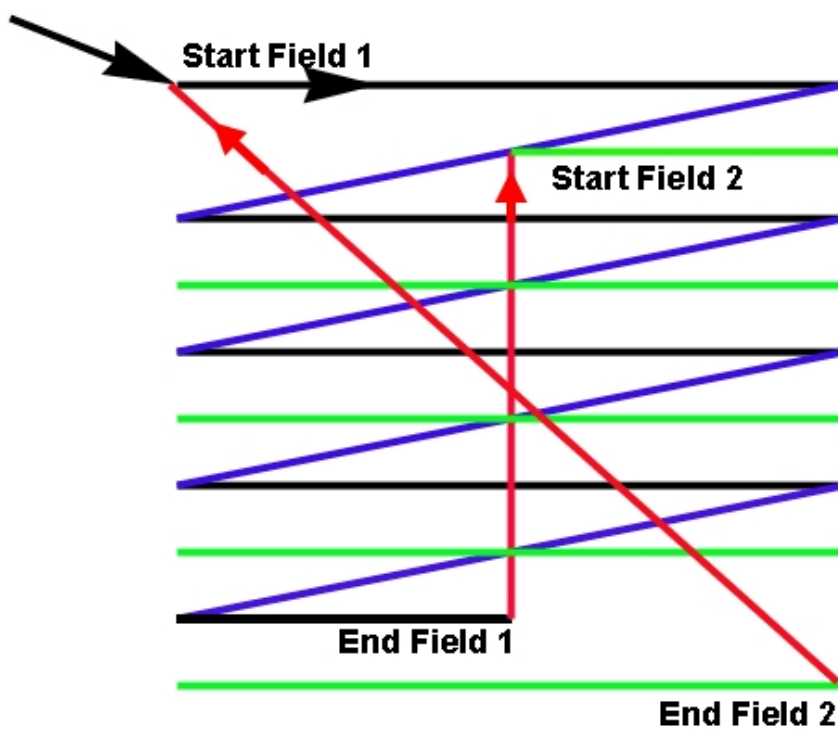

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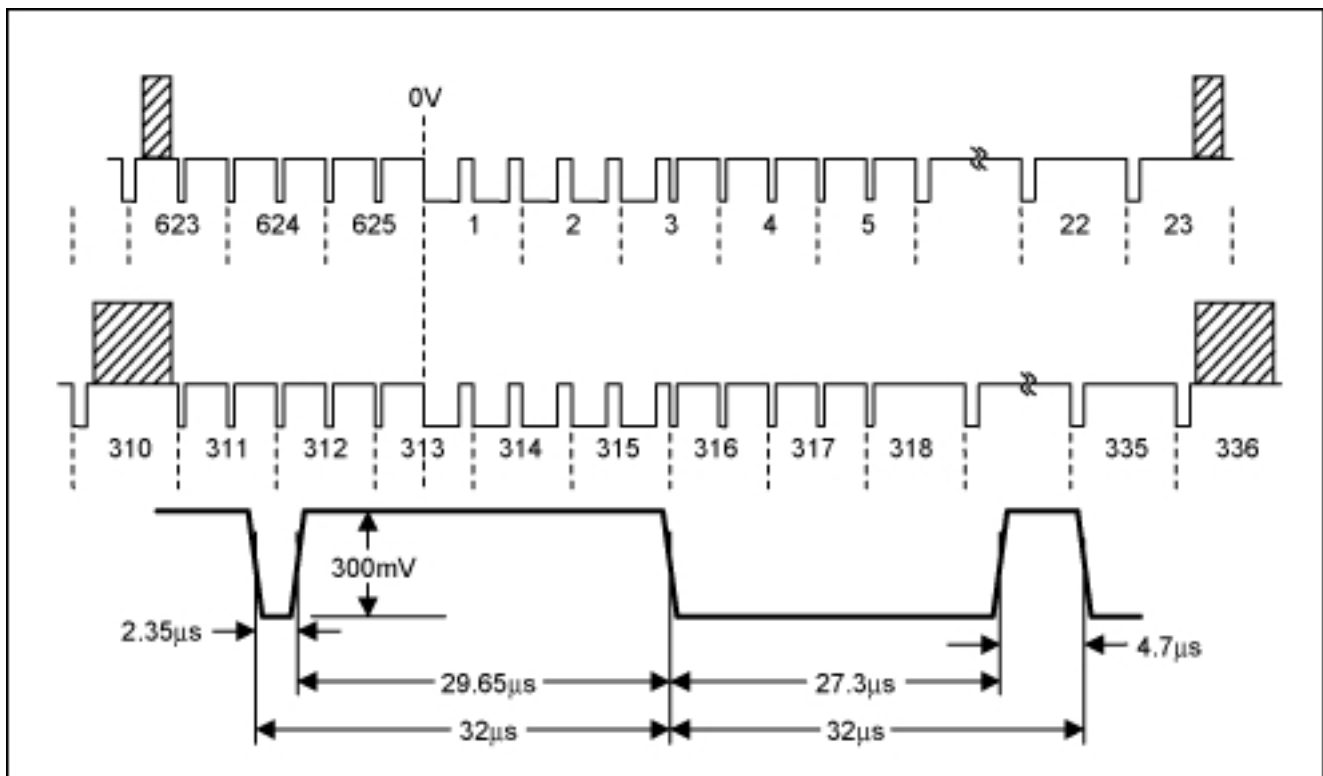
$$\text{Horizontal sync pulses} = 10 \text{ lines} = 2R \times 10/360$$
